PAST STATE COMMANDERS' AND PRESIDENTS' SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Eligibility: Any high school senior who is a child or a grandchild of an honorably discharged veteran and has a grade point average of at least 3.0. A current transcript of grades showing grade point average must be provided.

Funded By: Wyoming Past State Commanders of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Past State Auxiliary Presidents.

One \$500 Scholarship will be awarded each year. The Past State Commanders and the Past State Auxiliary Presidents shall select the recipient in June of each year at our State Convention.

All applications must be received no later than May 31, 2023. **Late or incomplete entries will not be judged.**

The selected scholarship recipient will be notified, and the \$500 scholarship award will be sent to the school chosen by the recipient. The scholarship funds may only be used for tuition, textbooks and lab fees.

The scholarship must be claimed within 3 years of date awarded.
